

MARKER TO STAMP TECHNIQUE

The marker to stamp technique is a fun and easy way to add different colors to a rubber stamp.

What you need to complete this technique:

- Rubber Stamp
- Water Based Markers like the Stampin' Write Markers from Stampin' Up!
- Clear Block if using clear mount stamps

Instructions:

1 - Pick out your stamp and the markers you wish to use.



2 - Next use one color, in this case the Early Espresso and color in desired area and repeat with the other two colors to fill in the other areas of the stamp. (You can use as many colors as you wish)



3 - Now lift up the stamp and blow on it, like a "huff" sound, (This creates moisture to ensure that the ink colors that were first applied will be wet for stamping) and stamp the image onto the card stock. You are done!
