



Tea Light Candle Tutorial

You can make these candles quickly and easily – a project that your children, grandchildren or neighbors or friends could help create for teachers or other special people for the holidays!



SUPPLIES/ACCESSORIES:

Sticky Strip (104294), Glass Stampin' Glitter – Champagne (120997), Silver (120995), and Paper Snips (103579) OTHER: Votive Candles (in glass holders); empty old stamp boxes

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Wrap the candle with a length of Sticky Strip – placement as desired – around the base or in stripes.
2. If doing different colored stripes – remove the red liner from only the stripes to be that color. Work over top of an old empty stamp box or scrap paper. Coat the Sticky Strip with Glass Stampin' Glitter, and press into the tape with your fingers, adding more as needed. Brush off any stray glitter pieces.
3. Remove red liner from remaining stripes and repeat with the other color of Stampin' Glitter. You are done! Place into a cello bag and tie with a ribbon for a perfect token for someone special!
