



Votive Candle Holder Tutorial

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This adorable gift can be made in less than five minutes for less than a few dollars apiece. Consider making a few extras to have on hand for hostess gifts and for people for whom you wish you had something at the ready. Change out the Washi Tape, candy and the candies and you can customize this for any holiday!





SUPPLIES:

- Clear glass votive candle holder
- Battery operated votive candle
- Small holiday colored candies such as M&Ms
- Sticky Strip (104294)
- Season of Style Designer Washi Tape (132155)
- Silver 1/8" Ribbon (132137)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Wrap green washi tape around base of battery operated votive candle. Cut length of Silver Ribbon to fit around base and apply sticky strip to the back of the ribbon and adhere around base over washi tape.
2. Form bow from length of Silver Ribbon and use small length of sticky strip to adhere to candle base, set aside.
3. Wrap red washi tape around votive holder being careful to keep top edge as level as possible; smooth lower edge, smoothing any tiny wrinkles with your fingernail.
4. Cut length of Silver Ribbon to fit around votive holder; apply Sticky Strip to back of ribbon and adhere over washi tape.
5. Form bow from length of Silver Ribbon and use small length of sticky strip to adhere to votive holder.
6. Fill votive holder with candies to about 2/3 of the way up; nestle battery operated votive candle in candies.

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
