Celebrating Mom on Mother's Day is a No Brainer! Create this Fun and Easy Card even if you only have ½ hour before she arrives to your door for dinner! Enjoy!

SUPPLIES:

- Stamp Set: Delightful Dozen (128547 W) (122652 C) *Retired Stamp Set After 5-31-14 or while supplies last.
- Card Stock: Shimmery White (101910), Rich Razzleberry (115316)
- Ink: Rich Razzleberry Blendabilities Assortment (131003), Daffodil Delight Blendabilities Assortment (130998, Skin Tone Blendabilities Assortment (129370), Memento Pad (132708), Rich Razzleberry Classic Ink (126950)
- Accessories: Stampin' Trimmer (126889), Hexagon Hive Thinlits Die (132965), Big Shot Die-Cut Machine (113439), Big Shot Magnetic Platform (130658) Rhinestone Basic Jewels (119246), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)
- Non-Stampin' Up!: Craft Metal

DIMENSIONS:

- 1. Cut Shimmery White Card Stock:
 - o 1 1/4" x 3 1/4"
 - o 3/4" x 2 2/8"
- 2. Cut Rich Razzleberry Card Stock:
 - o 1 ½" x 3 ½"
 - o 1 1/4" x 2 1/4"
- 3. Cut Craft Metal
 - o 1 ½ x 2 ½"
 - o 5" x 3 3/4"

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place 5" craft metal sheet in between an embossing folder of your choice run through Big Shot.
- 2. Next place embossed craft metal on cutting plate and lay Hexagon Hive Thinlit Die over it, place cutting place on top and run through Big Shot. Carefully punch out hexagons, use Sticky Strip or Fast Fuse on back of metal and adhere to card.
- 3. Stamp Image with Memento Ink onto 1 ¼ x 3 ¼ Shimmery White Card Stock and color with Blendabilities. Layer on top of Rich Razzleberry Card Stock adhere to card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 4. Color in Hexagons as desired.
- 5. Stamp "for My Wonderful Mother" in the Rich Razzleberry Classic Ink onto the Shimmery White Card Stock, layer on top of Rich Razzleberry and Craft Metal Layers, attach to card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Color Rhinestones using Rich Razzleberry Marker and place on card
- 7. You Are Done!
